

Pack 15 COVID Policy / Requirements:

Health and safety of our members, leaders and families is a priority, however, Pack 15 cannot be responsible or completely protect all from possible exposure to the virus. If you do not feel comfortable meeting in-person at any time we recommend that follow your beliefs and avoid it.

For people who would like to participate in person the following is a list of recommended guidelines to consider before gathering for den meetings, Pack meetings or Pack events.

Pre-Event Check List

- If you have been in contact with anyone who has COVID-19, is suspected of having COVID-19, is being tested for COVID-19, or is otherwise sick in the last 14 days, please stay home.
- If you are suffering from shortness of breath, new or worsening dry cough, fever of 100.4 or greater, flu like symptoms, vomiting or diarrhea, please stay home.
- If you are suffering from 2 or more of the following: cough, unexplained extreme fatigue or muscle aches, rash, sore throat or open sore, please stay home.

Pack Meetings

- Temperatures will be checked when entering the building and anyone with a temp of 100.4 will be asked to leave.
- At in-person pack meeting, to control group size we are asking that only one parent or care-taker accompany the scout or scouts. No siblings allowed unless they are a registered scout.
- Everyone (Scouts and adults) will be expected to wear face coverings while inside the building, before, during and after the meeting. We are planning to provide the registered scouts a mask to wear with either class A or B uniform. We will have paper mask at the door if you forget.
- Dens and accompanying parent will need to stay together and minimize contact with other dens. Parents we are relying on you to help your scout follow these rules.
- Den members will not be able to roam around the room. They will need to stay with their own den throughout the meeting to help reduce the spread of potential illnesses from one den to another.
- You will be asked to use the provided hand sanitizer as you enter and exit the building.
- Each den will be spaced at least 6 feet apart, and all social distancing between dens should be maintained as much as possible. However, given the space constraints this may not always be possible.
- When accepting awards, rather than hand shake use the Cub Scout salute.

Den Meetings

- Recommendations for indoor den meetings:
 - Parents we are relying on you to check for fever before showing up to a den meeting.
 - Keep spacing 6 feet apart if possible.
 - Wear masks provided or other face covering.
 - Minimize contact by keeping hands to yourself.
 - Use of hand sanitizer before and after meeting. Leaders will be provided with sanitizer.
- Recommendations for outdoor den meetings:
 - Keep spacing 6 feet apart.
 - Masks are recommended but optional.
 - Minimize contact by keeping hands to yourself.
 - Use of hand sanitizer before and after meeting. Leaders will be provided with sanitizer.
